SCRIP PROGRAM

The Scrip program sells gift cards from many retailers, restaurants, hotels, etc... When you buy Scrip gift cards through our school's Scrip program, you'll receive the full value of what you paid, and the school earns an immediate rebate percentage of what you spent – typically between 3% and 15%, depending on the retailer. We can use the proceeds to supplement the school budget, tuition assistance and other expenses.

All families that purchase at least \$200 per month, will earn an Out-Of-Uniform day for their children, scheduled by the school.

Please come to the office during school hours if you would like to order cards, or to set up a Scrip account to place your orders online.
