PURCHASE SCRIP GIFT CERTIFICATES

PRICE IS THE SAME AS CASH!

Retailers include grocers, restaurants, specialty stores, and more. Certificates are purchased by SJS from Great Lakes SCRIP Center at discounts ranging from 2-17%.

Benefits to using SCRIP

- 2% of your total purchases are credited toward your tuition in November and April!!! (The minimum credit issued will be \$5)
- Purchase \$250 of SCRIP in a month and your child qualifies for an OOU day the following month.

How do I purchase SCRIP?

- To order, simply fill out an order form for the SCRIP items you would like to purchase, total, attach payment (cash or check payable to SJS SCRIP), and return to the school office before 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday. Orders are ready on Thursday afternoon for pick-up in the school office or delivery in the Family Envelope (you **must** sign the release authorization on the bottom of the order form to receive SCRIP in your Family Envelope).
