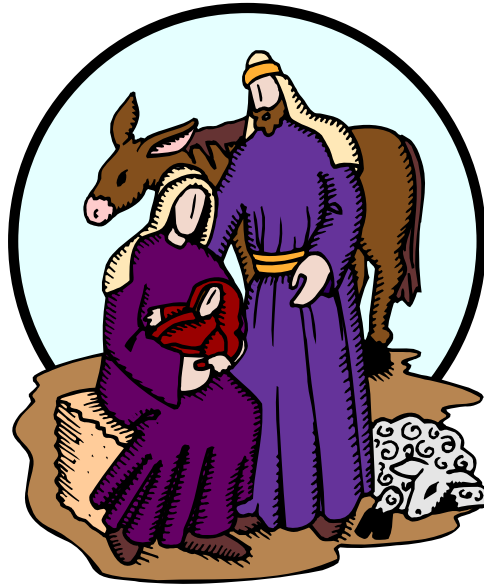
DID YOU KNOW
