ELIGIBILITY FOR PARTICIPATION - REVISED

We are updating our Eligibility for Participation policy that can be found on p. 31, first bullet point, of the the *SJS Parent/Student Handbook*. This change, which will be effective January 7, 2010, is because of the improved communication involved with recording, checking, and reporting of grades on RenWeb. The policy will now read as follows:

- Students are required to maintain at least a "D" in each subject. Any student who receives a failing grade in a subject on a progress report or a report card cannot participate in any sports activity. Grades will be checked at one week and again at two weeks following the failing report, and if the student is passing all subjects at either time, eligibility can be reinstated.
